n a step that sets them apart from many peer design companies, Swindon-based Illsley Wilson Baylis (IWB) is benefiting from secure and controllable Internet access — and the result so far is better customer service and higher staff morale.

According to IT manager Chris Waddell, since the installation of Equiinet's

NetPilot Internet server appliance the 20 staff at IWB have been able to deliver client visuals immediately instead of wasting time waiting for the one workstation with e-mail access to become free.

"We used to have just a single workstation with a single modem connection and I think that's likely to be the case for a lot of design studios," says Chris. "The NetPilot has sped up our production process no end, as every user is able to send client visuals as PDF files from their own workstation.

"But there's not just an external benefit, there's also the internal one. This comes on top of a lot of other recent investment and it's the icing on the cake for our people. It's a tremendous empowerment tool which has really improved the quality of life in the work area."

And that empowerment is helping IWB better serve clients as diverse at the Tussauds Group, Bayer, Twinings, Vodafone and Daler-Rowney.

Mac Compatible

Although most NetPilot applications take place in a Windows environment, IWB — who purchased the NetPilot through Internet service provider Star Internet — needed Macintosh-compatibility and Chris Waddell found it simple to configure the system for Mac usage. "It bedded in very quickly and

there have been no problems at all," he says.

"In fact, I think it's slightly easier to install on a Macintosh system than in a Windows environment. It was a doddle with the Mac."

Easy InstallationWith a background in

graphic design and no formal computer training, Chris rose to the challenge of installing the NetPilot himself, saying, "I don't think everybody could install it, but the fact I'm not a specialist is a good indicator of how easy it is." He now maintains the system with the help of IWB's web master


state-of-the-art firewalling facilities to guarantee network security and web 'boundary caching' for fast response and best utilisation of the Internet connection.
